## Current Affairs Related to 9 February 2026

- ◆ **The Reserve Bank of India has advanced its scheduled open market operation purchases.** The central bank will now inject 1 lakh crore of liquidity into the system through the purchase of government securities to stabilize liquidity conditions and calm negative sentiment in the bond market. The RBI has revised the timings of its OMO purchases of government securities. This decision was taken after liquidity in the banking system fell rapidly below the normal level and bond yields reached an 11-month high.
- ◆ **Indian Railways has taken a significant step in the direction of railway modernization.** An AI-powered robot named AACC Arjun has been deployed at Visakhapatnam Railway Station. It has been developed with the aim of strengthening security and passenger services. This robot, through artificial intelligence, automation, and indigenous innovation, aims to develop secure public infrastructure, reflecting Indian Railways' increasing focus on technology. The deployment of AACC Arjun is a significant milestone for the Indian Railways network. Its purpose is to assist in security, surveillance, and crowd management.
- ◆ **As the central parliamentary session is underway, all eyes are on the Economic Survey 2026,** a crucial document that shapes India's economic direction. Considered the report card of the Indian economy, it is of immense importance to policymakers, students, universities, and everyone interested in the country's economic health. In this article, we discuss what the Economic Survey is, when it is released, and how it differs from the Union Budget. The Economic Survey is an annual document prepared by the Department of Economic Affairs of the Ministry of Finance under the supervision of the Chief Economic Advisor to the Government of India.
- ◆ **K. Pazhanivel has been awarded the Padma Shri for his contribution** to traditional martial arts. He is a prominent Silambam artist from Puducherry. This award recognizes his role in the preservation and promotion of Silambam. He began his training in Silambam under the guidance of Master Rajaram. He has worked to popularize Silambam in India. He is known as a skilled practitioner and dedicated teacher.
- ◆ **The Jeevan Raksha Padak series of awards for 2025** has been approved by the President of India.
- ◆ **Indian researchers at the International Advanced Research Centre for Powder Metallurgy and New Materials** have developed a new high-voltage supercapacitor. This supercapacitor uses porous graphene carbon nanocomposite electrodes. It operates at 3.4 volts, which is significantly higher than the typical 2.5-3.0 volt range of commercial supercapacitors. The electrode material has been made water-resistant and is highly compatible with organic electrolytes. This reduces electrolyte degradation at high voltages, and the porous structure allows for rapid electrolyte penetration.
- ◆ **Nagaland's first drone school and drone excellence center was inaugurated at the Nagaland GIS and Remote Sensing Centre in Kohima.** The facility was formally inaugurated by Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio on the occasion of the 77th Republic Day celebrations. This state-of-the-art initiative has been developed under the State GIS and Remote Sensing Centre of the Planning and Transformation Department. The drone school has been established to equip young people with advanced drone technology skills and promote innovation-based employment.
- ◆ **The RBI and the European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA) have signed** a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU). This MoU relates to cooperation and exchange of information concerning central counterparties regulated and supervised by the RBI. This MoU provides a framework for ESMA to rely on the RBI's regulatory and supervisory activities while safeguarding the financial stability of the European Union. This MoU highlights the importance of cross-border regulatory cooperation for the smooth functioning of international clearing activities.
- ◆ **India and Canada signed a joint statement on energy cooperation.** This signing took place during Energy Week 2026 held in Goa. This agreement strengthens bilateral cooperation in the energy sector and encompasses both conventional and clean energy sources. The statement was issued after a meeting between India's Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Hardeep Singh Puri, and Canada's Minister of Energy and Natural Resources, Timothy Hodgson. The meeting also marked the revival of the India-Canada Ministerial Energy Dialogue.


